RE: Rule Change

Dear Homeowner:

In accordance with California Civil Code 4360, the Association must post notice of proposed rule changes, stating the purpose and effect, to the membership at least twenty-eight (28) days before making the change or adopting a new rule.

The purpose and effect of the rule change is as follows:

- 1) Remove the delinquency policy from the Rules and Regulations making the Delinquency Policy a standalone document. This will allow the Board to adjust it as needed going forward since it is a policy and not a rule.
- 2) Add the Board approval to pass the Notice of Past Due Assessment processing cost charged to the Association, in the amount of \$30 per late letter, on to the delinquent homeowner. This fee is in addition to the existing late charge the Association already charges late-paying homeowners. The \$30 fee will be passed on to late-paying homeowners rather than being borne by the Association.

The Board will vote on this proposed rule and regulation document change at the next scheduled Board meeting.
